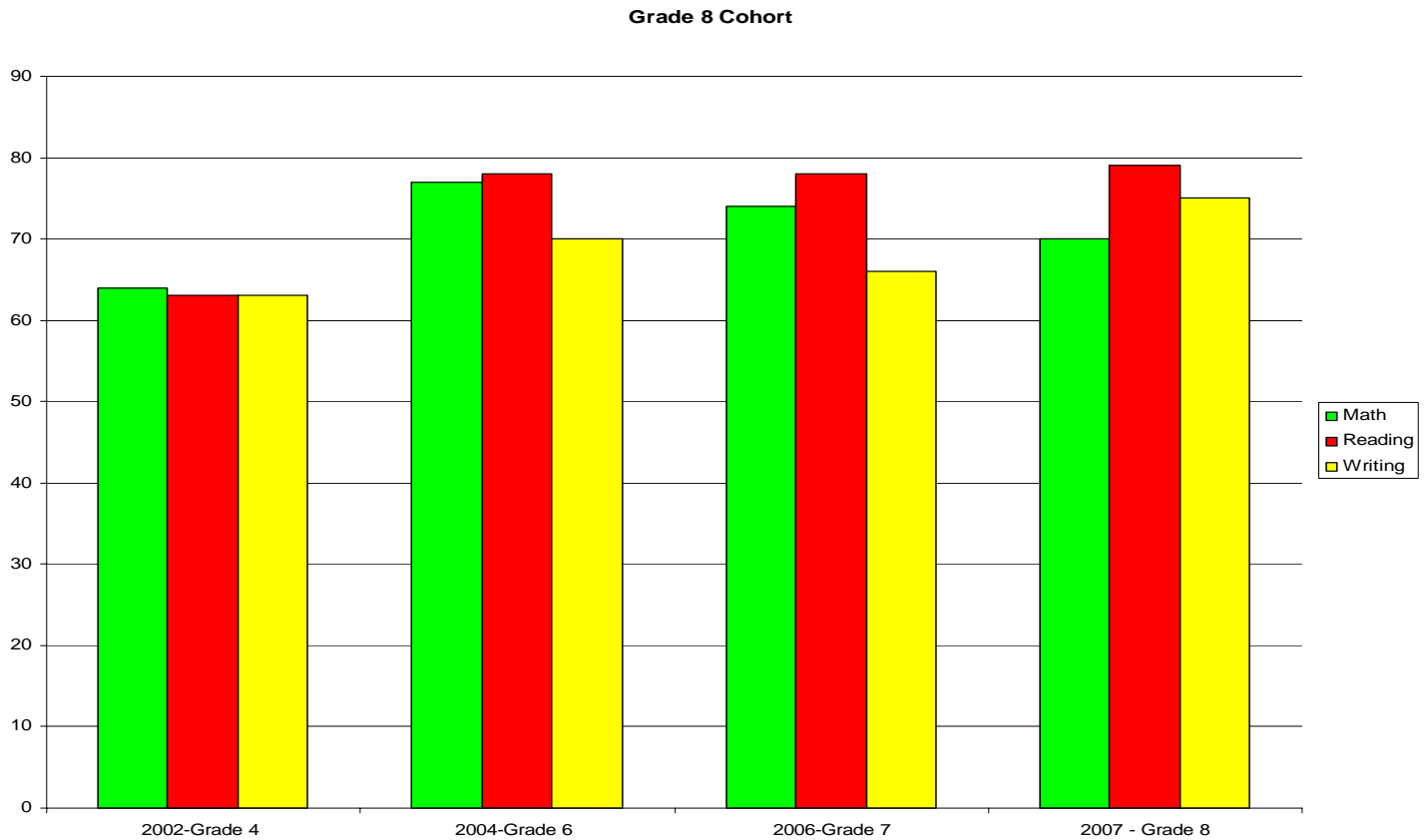

2006 Goal # 1
