	<p>Mim reviewed the proposed program of studies for the middle school for 2007-08, noting some changes that will need to be made. She stated that the Transition Committee is meeting twice a month and they are beginning to schedule students in preparation for parent orientation meetings.</p> <p>Gary asked if this program conforms to the HKEA current labor agreement. Mim stated there are some issues that need to be resolved, which is why this document is a draft.</p> <p>Mim reviewed the middle school program of studies for 2007-08, the certification issues, the team plan, the anticipated enrollment and the tentative daily schedule, which is based on an eight period day. Gary asked her to provide a comparison of the present instructional time in grades 5-8 with the instructional time for the proposed new schedule. Mim noted that there would be 310 instructional minutes for grades 5 and 6. Under the proposed schedule, there would be 277 instructional minutes for grades seven and eight compared to the current 255 instructional minutes. Mim noted that the plan will be presented to the Board tonight at their meeting. The schedule will be brought to the May 1 Curriculum Council meeting for action.</p>
