Budget News

The 2017-18 budget process has begun. After careful consideration and deliberation, the Superintendent will present his proposed budget in early March. Then the Board of Education conducts a series of public meetings and workshops to review the budget, finalize it and present it to the community for a vote. Special Education, Health Insurance and contract obligations are responsibilities that must be taken into account. In addition are the numerous unfunded and underfunded State and Federal Mandates. There are many aspects of the budget to review and we invite the public to be part of the process at any of our special or regular meetings this coming spring.

A BOE Strategic Capital Planning Subcommittee has been formed to review the needs of our capital assets, the funding of the Capital Fund and will develop a capital plan and associated policies and procedures to govern it.

On Monday December 19, the BOE met with the Killingworth and Haddam BOS and BOF to discuss budget concerns. This was a very beneficial meeting so that all could hear and understand the challenges the towns and schools face. There was discussion on how we can better communicate and what resources might be available to ease the taxpayer burden. It was agreed that future meetings would be important.
