We are working in conjunction with Ecophones, an environmentally friendly company which will pay us for items shipped to them. Their technicians then recondition and resell 80% of the electronics. Any remaining items that they are unable to refurbish are sent to an eco-friendly company in Europe which then disposes of them safely.

Items need not be in working order or have a charged battery. No accessories, such as, chargers, cases, or earpieces will be accepted.

This will be an ongoing fundraiser which will help to make each year of Project Graduation a success. In addition, we can all take small steps to better our environment.
