A. High School Energy and Facilities Upgrade (CREC Project)

He explained that CREC presented a proposal for roof replacement, boiler repairs and possible energy-saving upgrades that could offset the cost of heating and electricity as a part of the proposal. He said that the subcommittee has been looking at a lot of different scenarios. Jeannie Young mentioned that she would like to make sure that the specifications from CREC can be put out to bid by all of the major roofing companies in the area to ensure that the district gets the best product at the best pricing.
