OFFICERS

- 1. The Board shall, not later than one month following the date on which newly elected members take office, elect from its membership a Chairperson, a Vice Chairperson, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and may prescribe their duties.
- 2. The votes of each member cast in such election shall be reduced to writing and made available for public inspection within forty-eight hours, and shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting at which they are taken, which minutes shall be available for public inspection at all reasonable times.
- 3. Officers shall hold their respective offices for two years and until their successors are duly elected, except in case of removal as provided in Section 9222. A Board Chair may serve no more than two consecutive terms.
- 4. Should a vacancy arise in an office of the Board, the members of the Board (including, if applicable, the member vacating a Board office) shall elect a successor to fill the office until the next regular election for Board officers.
