## OFFICERS

1. The Board shall, not later than one month following the date on which newly elected members take office, elect from its membership a Chairperson, a Vice Chairperson, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and may prescribe their duties.
2. The votes of each member cast in such election shall be reduced to writing and made available for public inspection within forty-eight hours, and shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting at which they are taken, which minutes shall be available for public inspection at all reasonable times.
3. Officers shall hold their respective offices for two years and until their successors are duly elected, except in case of removal as provided in Section 9222. A Board Chair may serve no more than two consecutive terms.
4. Should a vacancy arise in an office of the Board, the members of the Board (including, if applicable, the member vacating a Board office) shall elect a successor to fill the office until the next regular election for Board officers.
