Video Cameras on School Buses

The Board of Education recognizes the need to maintain appropriate conduct on school buses. Accordingly, the Board of Education authorizes, when appropriate, the installation of video cameras on school buses as an aid in monitoring student behavior. These cameras produce both video and audio coverage. The tapes from these cameras may be used to assist school administrators in deciding upon appropriate disciplinary action.
