Report from Student Representatives

Erin Buckley reported that December was a busy month especially for the HKTV crew and students who put on the Holiday Show for "Team Avery". Avery is a child who suffers from seizures. She has a rare genetic mutation of CDKL5. As of last week, over \$22.000 had been raised and they are still counting. Students were encouraged to donate in homeroom, and in return students received green wristbands. When Avery and her family arrived at the High School, they could see student support evident everywhere by all the students with wristbands. Mr. Mackenzie's class raised over \$1300.

In follow up to Rachel's Challenge, student council made a paper chain. Each link contains a random act of kindness performed. The chain now lines the walls in the High School outside the main office and is a perfect reminder of the assembly.

Erin stated that Mid Terms begin on the 24th. High School students will have ½ days during exams. Also juniors have begun to talk about colleges and Naviance accounts have been set up for them. This website, similar to College Board, offers information and lists about colleges that fit specific criteria such as major, size, and location. A group of juniors will have the opportunity to take online courses through Middlesex College in varying subjects.

The drama department is busy with auditions for this year's play, Arsenic and Old Lace.
