Board Liaison Reports

A. Curriculum Council Update

Susan Dean updated the Board. She reported that Heather Rigatti made a presentation about the Smarter Balanced Digital Library. She said that teachers can register and get more information. She also reported that Jason Leavings and Heather Tooker presented a new edition of the Honors Chemistry textbook for consideration by the Council. Updates regarding curriculum were also given by each school as well as Pupil Services, the Superintendent and the Assistant Superintendent.

B. Curriculum Subcommittee

Dan Chase updated the Board. He reported that the Subcommittee met last on January 15, 2015. A presentation on the new courses and textbooks discussed is listed on the Board agenda for this meeting.

A. High School Graduation Policy

The Board discussed the GPA Scale chart at some length and determined that it may want to further review the GPA Scale and Weighted Grading policies before approval. New Business

A. New Course and Textbook Proposals (HKHS)

Dan Chase presented the proposed Astronomy textbook, <u>ASTRO</u>, published in 2014. Astronomy is an elective science course open to Grades 10-12. The teacher has not been using a textbook, but primary resources for course materials. The new textbook will be used as a classroom resource to provide basic astronomic information. The textbook is estimated to cost approximately \$63.75 per book. The Board briefly discussed this class and textbook, as well as science textbook pricing in general.

Dan Chase presented the proposed UCONN Environmental Science textbook, <u>Environmental Science</u> for AP. UCONN Environmental Science is an elective science course open to Grades 11-12 for which students can obtain college credit. This textbook would replace a textbook from 2007 that is currently in use. The new textbook is one of the textbooks recommended by UCONN for use with this course. A 2015 edition is currently in print and will be available for next year's course offering. The textbook is estimated to cost approximately \$170.00 per book. The Board briefly discussed this textbook.

Dan Chase presented the proposed Project Lead the Way: Computer Science and Software Engineering course for HKHS. The course will be a year-long course available to students in Grades 10-12. Region 17 offers several Project Lead the Way courses and all course curriculum materials would be provided by Project Lead the Way. The teacher who will be teaching this course will need to attend training at a cost of approximately \$3,062.00 including travel expenses. The Board briefly discussed this course.

Dan Chase then presented the proposed Project Lead the Way: Biological Engineering (BioE) course for HKHS. The course will be available to students in Grades 10-12 who have taken Biology or an Environmental Science course. There will be some additional equipment required for the course, which may cost up to \$7,000.00, however the Science Department feels confident they will be able to use a lot of equipment they already have on hand. Annual costs for materials may be approximately \$1,000. The teacher who will be teaching this course will need to attend training at a cost of approximately \$3,000.00 including travel expenses. The Board briefly discussed this couse.
